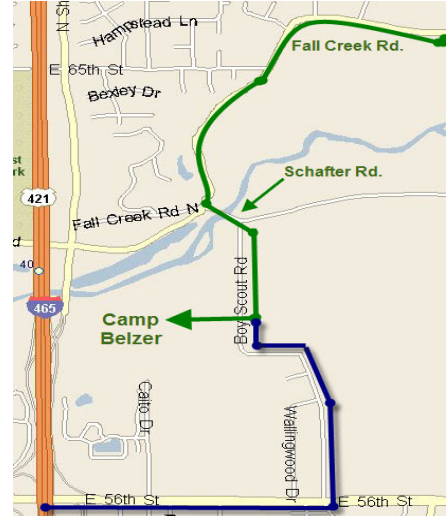


First Day at Camp Belzer

HOW to get to CAMP BELZER

Most people get to Camp Belzer from Fishers by going South on Brooks School Rd to Fall Creek, turning right (southwest) until they get to Schafer Rd which becomes Boy Scout Road. (Green route)

Alternately, you could go I-465 to 56th Street East and go North on Boy Scout Rd. (Blue route)



UPON ARRIVAL

In the parking lot you will see a great big “Welcome” sign. Go to the sign and tell a staffer that you are with Pack 122. They will tell you which “tribe” you are in.



Basically, the tribe is their way assigning each pack to a different color, like in 2009 when we were the Blue Tribe. Now walk to the picnic tables with a big flag that has your tribe’s color and check in with our camp coordinator.



ORIENTATION

You will get a schedule and a map. While the camp coordinator should be able to get you going in the right direction, it really is pretty simple once you get the hang of it.

The schedule tells you what station your boys should go to at what time. The map tells you where that station is. I have always found it easier to read the map as if the picnic area we meet is the center from which all of the activities radiate.
